Week	Focus	Objectives (abbreviated)
1	My Name & Body	Identify body parts, write/trace name, label drawings
2	Emotions	Name feelings, match facial expressions, express needs verbally
3	My Family	Draw family portrait, describe family members, roles
4	Routines & Rules	Follow routines, use manners, clean up after self

Math: Counting up to 5, recognizing shapes Literacy: Recognizing first letter of name, letter A-B Science: Senses and body exploration Social Studies: Family roles and home/school rules Fine Arts: Finger painting, family collage Motor Skills: Hop, jump, trace lines and curves

## Repeat Structure Monthly with themed adaptations:

#### Ctober – Theme: Fall & Helpers

- Fire safety drills (social/emotional)
- Leaf sorting (science + math)
- Visit from community helper or virtual video
- Letters C–F, numbers 1–10

#### **November – Theme: Food & Gratitude**

- Letters G–J, counting to 15
