# World Geography Studies

Strand 1: History

- Analyze how physical and human geographic factors have influenced major historical events and movements
- □ Trace the influence of major river valley civilizations on cultural regions
- Identify and analyze ways geography has influenced the development of countries and regions

# Strand 2: Geography

- Create and interpret maps, including thematic and political maps
- □ Identify and locate major landforms, countries, and cities
- Explain the interaction between physical processes (e.g., climate, tectonics) and human activities
- Analyze how humans adapt to and modify their environment
- Describe patterns of population distribution, settlement, and migration
- Examine urbanization and how it affects environments and societies
- □ Compare ways cultures adapt to their environment based on geographic factors

### Strand 3: Economics

- Describe the spatial distribution of economic activities
- Compare global trade patterns and economic systems (market, command, mixed)
- □ Examine the impact of geography on economic development
- □ Evaluate how resources and infrastructure influence economic activities and decisions

# Strand 4: Government and Citizenship

- □ Identify and compare characteristics of various political systems
- □ Examine relationships between geography and political boundaries



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□ Analyze the impact of borders, conflict, and cooperation among societies

#### Strand 5: Culture

- □ Identify and compare elements of culture (language, religion, customs, institutions)
- □ Analyze the spread of cultural traits and cultural diffusion
- Describe how cultural factors influence the character of places and regions
- □ Examine issues related to cultural convergence and divergence

### Strand 6: Science, Technology, and Society

- Evaluate how advances in technology influence how people interact with the environment
- □ Analyze the impact of transportation and communication systems on global interactions

### Strand 7: Social Studies Skills

- Use geographic tools like maps, globes, and GIS to analyze geographic issues
- □ Interpret graphs, charts, and visuals to draw conclusions
- □ Apply critical-thinking skills to organize and interpret social studies information
- □ Communicate and support written and oral arguments using evidence
